

MORE DIFFICULT CRAFT

Resources: 2 paper plates, Coloured pens, crayons, felt tipped pens or highlighters
2 cut out people (Jesus & John), 2 split pins, 2 lolly sticks



1. Colour one plate – face up towards you
- Yellow/orange to represent rocky, sandy background
(you don't have to colour in the whole plate if you don't want to just the middle section – but right across)

2. Turn one other plate upside down and colour in the underside blue to represent water & sky (just the top third and the bottom half)



3. Cut out Jesus and John the Baptist, inserting the split pins as indicated (sorry, you only have two, so unless you have another pin, stick on John's right arm) Then glue them to the lolly sticks.

4. Now cut the bottom plate in a straight line across the middle, and the top third. (Set aside the bit left over as you can use it for extra bits later (ie cut out small dove, or clouds, or rocks, or a bush etc – up to you).

5. Stick the two plates together around the edges – the second bottom bit and top bit on to the plate, coloured yellow – leaving a small gap at the bottom for the lolly

6. Insert Jesus and John and get them acting out Jesus' baptism. If you want to stick any extra bits – like foliage, a dove, stones, cloud – add these to the picture now..
